LRA Accessibility Audit: Initial Review

BT48 | September 2020

Summary

The site as it currently stands would fail an accessibility audit at AA level. There are a small number of technical issues which if addressed will improve the site accessibility dramatically. These include:

- 1. Use of an accessible slideshow module
- 2. Update ARIA labelling on templates
- 3. Ensuring automatically generated link text is descriptive
- 4. Updating contact form to improve accessibility

The major issue that we can see with improving accessibility of the site in the short term outside simple technical fixes lies in the MMenu plugin used for a slide in menu on smaller screens. It may be a case of replacing that module with a more accessible alternative or outlining the mitigating factors behind retaining it.

We are confident that a small number of technical improvements will ensure that the site will meet AA standards by the September deadline.
